- Assume you are a speech writer for the President of the United States. Write a speech to be delivered on Memorial Day, keeping in mind the sacrifices of our veterans.
- Find a quote you believe appropriately honors or summarizes Memorial Day. Explain why you believe this quote relates to Memorial Day.
- Consider the sacrifices soldiers, sailors, marines, airmen and coast guardsmen have made, and make, for our country. Write a letter to a soldier, real or fictitious, thanking them for their service.
- Write an essay on why it is important for Americans to honor Memorial Day.
