Help us design the 2021 seals for gas pumps, scanners and scales.

For high school level students living in Medina County, including homeschoolers and those who attend school outside the county.

Top 6 seals in each division will be displayed county wide.

Rules for Seals:

- **SIZE:** Must be 2.75" in any direction of a rectangle, circle, square or other shape.
- Each entry submitted must be camera-ready. **On the back of the entry, list the following: Student name, Student Email, Grade, Student Phone Number, Parent Phone Number, Parent Email, Name of High School (or home-schooled), Name of Teacher if the design is part of a class project.**
- The entry should be submitted on a re-writable CD in a form readable by the commercial printer. JPEG is NOT acceptable. Adobe Illustrator format preferred. Preferable formats are EPS or PDF. Scanned formats are not acceptable.
- **Proofread carefully.** No omissions, no misspellings. Errors negatively impact the design's chances of winning.

The following text information must be on any entries intended for device approval seals:

- The name, "MIKE KOVACK" should be in capital letters and prominently displayed on the seal in an easy-to-read font. "Medina County Auditor," in all caps or upper and lower case should be prominently displayed.
- The year of inspection must be prominently displayed. This is "2021-2022."
- The sticker must say, "Inspected and Sealed" and be easily read.
- The auditor's office website must be on the sticker. It is www.medinacountyauditor.org.
- The auditor's phone number must be listed with the area code. The number should read: (330) 725-9764. The toll free number should be listed also: (844) 722-3800.
- The designer's name must be included on the sticker in an inconspicuous, but readable manner.
- The rules for entries for price verification stickers are the same as above EXCEPT "Inspected and Sealed" is not included. Instead use "Passed Price Verification" and "Equity in the Market Place". The font for statements may be smaller to accommodate space on sticker.
- Colors and artwork are left to your imagination. Make sure images are high resolution. The seal will be publicly displayed and must be easy to read. This is a prime consideration for judging.
- There are 2 first place winners, one in each division. Winners can expect to see their stickers displayed around the county in 2021 on commercial devices inspected by the Auditor's Office.

Entries must be received in the Auditor's Office by Friday, November 20.

Winners will be notified in December.
