**The Medina County Auditor and Medina County Recorder today announced that they will be closing their offices one hour early one day a week to accommodate reductions in their budgets. Michael Kovack and Colleen Swedyk indicated the changes would take place March 1<sup>st</sup>. The changes amount to a 2.5% pay reduction for full time employees.**

**Both offices have eliminated positions due to the budget cuts, but vowed to continue to meet the needs of county residents. “We realize times are difficult all over,” Auditor Kovack said. “This minor change will allow us to continue to provide excellent customer service while dealing with the budget crunch the county is facing.” Recorder Swedyk said “I believe Medina County residents understand sacrifices need to be made during tough economic times.”**

**Beginning March 1<sup>st</sup> office hours will be 8 am until 4:30 pm Monday through Thursday. On Fridays the offices will be open from 8 am until 3:30 pm.**
