

## **HOMEOWNERS SUFFERING STORM DAMAGE MAY RECEIVE REDUCTION ON TAXABLE VALUE**

### **For Immediate Release**

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In light of the heavy storms Medina County sustained this week which included strong winds and hail in some areas, Medina County Auditor Michael E. Kovack reminds property owners and owners of manufactured homes that they may claim a reduction in the taxable value of structural property that is destroyed or damaged.

Ohio law enables property owners and owners of manufactured homes to claim the reduction regardless of the cause of the damage. The amount of reduction is prorated based on the calendar quarter in which the damage occurred. Property owners must file an application with the Auditor's Office for a reduction no later than December 31st in the year that the damage occurred. For property damage that occurs during the last quarter of the calendar year, applications must be filed no later than January 31st. Refunds or credits may be available.

County Auditor Michael E. Kovack noted, "With the severity of these storms, residents of Medina County who suffered structural damage deserve the assistance that this law provides. That assistance is quick and effective property tax relief to those homeowners with damaged property."
