

HOME RELIEF GRANT

COMMUNITY ACTION WAYNE/MEDINA

Residents who are behind on rent, mortgage, and water and/or sewer utility bills may be able to receive assistance. Assistance can be applied to outstanding rent, mortgage, water, and/or sewer bills back to April 1, 2020.

Documents needed to apply:

- Names of all household members
- Date of Birth
- Social Security Number
- Current or Previous address
- Copies of Social Security cards for each household member
- Proof of Citizenship or legal residency for each household
- Proof of income for all household members 18 years or older for a minimum of the past 30 days
- Any supporting documentation to demonstrate need
- Hardship due to the COVID-19 pandemic

Households with an annual income at or below 200% of the federal poverty guidelines will be eligible for assistance. For a family of four, that is an annual income up to \$52,400.



To receive Rental Assistance, additional information:

- Eviction or past due rent notice. Notice should include total amount due (including fees)
- If moving to a new location, justification for the move (i.e. currently homeless, living with another family and not sufficient space etc.)
- Landlord verification/proof of ownership and agreement to receive funds
- Lease agreement

To receive Mortgage Assistance, additional information:

- Notice of late mortgage payment (including taxes and insurance)

To receive Utility Assistance, additional information:

- Copy of utility bill demonstrating the account has been shutoff, is in disconnect status or is past due

Community Action Wayne/Medina is offering Emergency Assistance for Homeowners and Renters in Wayne and Medina Counties affected by Coronavirus (COVID-19).

CAW/M may be able to assist households:

- Facing eviction or late notice from their landlord;
- Are homeless or experiencing imminent homelessness;
- Mortgage delinquency or forbearance unable to pay their mortgage and have verification of past due payment;
- Threat of disconnection of water and sewer utility

Rental arrears, mortgage delinquencies and past due amounts from April 1, 2020 may be paid.



WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Households with income at or below 200% of the federal poverty guidelines. The income levels are:

Household 1	up to \$25,520
Household 2	up to \$34,480
Household 3	up to \$43,440
Household 4	up to \$52,400
Household 5	up to \$61,360
Household 6	up to \$70,320
Household 7	up to \$79,280
Household 8	up to \$88,240
